

Maximum Global Business Online Privacy Statement

Last Updated: June 24, 2008.

Maximum Global Business is committed to protecting your privacy. Please read the Maximum Global Business Online Privacy Statement below about particular Maximum Global Business sites and services that you may use.

This Maximum Global Business Online Privacy Statement applies to data collected by Maximum Global Business through the majority of its websites and services, as well as its offline product support services. It does not apply to those Maximum Global Business sites, services and products that do not display or link to this statement or that have their own privacy statements.

Collection of Your Personal Information

At some Maximum Global Business sites, we ask you to provide personal information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. We may also collect demographic information, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites. Maximum Global Business will not ask for information such as your tax identification number, social security number, credit card number or billing address that is used to create a Maximum Global Business billing account.

In order to access some Maximum Global Business services, you will be asked to sign in with an e-mail address and password, which we refer to as your credentials. In most cases, these credentials are administered by third parties where the sites are hosted. You can use the same credentials to sign in to many different Maximum Global Business sites and services, as well as those of select Maximum Global Business partners. By signing in on one Maximum Global Business site or service, you may be automatically signed into other Maximum Global Business sites and services. If you access our services via a mobile phone, you may also use your telephone number and a PIN as an alternative credential to your username and password. As part of creating your credentials, you may also be requested to provide questions and secret answers, which we use to help verify your identity and assist in resetting your password, as well as an alternate email address. Some services may require added security, and in these cases, you may be asked to create an additional security key. Finally, a unique ID number will be assigned to your credentials which will be used to identify your credentials and associated information.

We may collect information about your visit, including the pages you view, the links you click and other actions taken in connection with Maximum Global Business sites and services. We also deliver advertisements and provide website analytics tools on non-Maximum Global Business sites and services, and we may collect information about page views on these third party sites as well. Much of this third party ad delivery is done through Homestead Technologies and Google's Blogger. Additionally, we collect certain standard information that your browser sends to every website you visit, such as your IP address, browser type and language, access times and referring Web site addresses.

Use of Your Personal Information

Maximum Global Business collects and uses your personal information to operate and improve its sites and deliver the services or carry out the transactions you have requested. These uses may include providing you with more effective customer service; making the sites or services easier to use by eliminating the need for you to repeatedly enter the same information; performing research and analysis aimed at improving our products, services and technologies; and displaying content and advertising that are customized to your interests and preferences.

Many of the websites and online services we offer are supported by advertising, and as indicated above, we may use some of the information we collect in order to personalize the ads we show you. However, we designed our systems to select ads based only on data that does not personally and directly identify you. For example, we may select the ads we display according to certain general interest categories or segments that we have inferred based on (a) demographic data, including any you may have provided when creating an account (e.g. age, zip or postal code, gender), general demographic data acquired from other companies, and a general geographic location derived from your IP address, (b) the pages you view and links you click when using Maximum Global Business 's and its partners' web sites and services.

When we display personalized ads, we take a number of steps designed to protect your privacy. For example, we store page views, clicks and search terms used for ad personalization separately from your contact information or other data that directly identifies you (such as your name, e-mail address, etc.). Further, we have built in technological and process safeguards designed to prevent the unauthorized correlation of this data.

We also use your personal information to communicate with you. We may send certain mandatory service communications such as welcome letters, billing reminders, information on technical service issues, and security announcements.

Personal information collected on Maximum Global Business sites and services may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country in which Maximum Global Business or its affiliates, subsidiaries or agents maintain facilities, and by using a Maximum Global Business site or service, you consent to any such transfer of information outside of your country. Maximum Global Business abides by the safe harbor framework as set forth by the U.S. Department of Commerce regarding the collection, use, and retention of data from the European Union.

Sharing of Your Personal Information

Except as described in this statement, we will not disclose your personal information outside of Maximum Global Business and its controlled subsidiaries and affiliates without your consent. Some Maximum Global Business sites allow you to choose to share your personal information with select Maximum Global Business partners so that they can contact you about their products, services or offers. See the [Communication Preferences](#) section below for more information.

Some Maximum Global Business services may be co-branded and offered in conjunction with another company. If you register for or use such services, both Maximum Global Business and the other company may receive information collected in conjunction with the co-branded services.

We occasionally hire other companies to provide limited services on our behalf, such as handling the processing and delivery of mailings, providing customer support, hosting websites, processing transactions, or performing statistical analysis of our services. Those companies will be permitted to obtain only the personal information they need to deliver the service. They are required to maintain the confidentiality of the information and are prohibited from using it for any other purpose.

We may access and/or disclose your personal information if we believe such action is necessary to: (a) comply with the law or legal process served on Maximum Global Business; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Maximum Global Business (including the enforcement of our agreements); or (c) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Maximum Global Business services or members of the public.

Accessing Your Personal Information

You may have the ability to view or edit your personal information online. In order to help prevent your personal information from being viewed by others, you will be required to sign in with your credentials (e-mail address and password). The appropriate method(s) for accessing your personal information will depend on which sites or services you have used.

- **MaximumGlobalBusiness .com** – We provide a contact form to collect your first name, last name, company, title, email, telephone, and best time to call. You can update this information by submitting a request to info@maximumglobalbusiness.com
- **The Dynamics GP Blogster** – This site collects your user ID and/or email when posting a comment in response to a blog. Since Blogger is hosted by Google, you are bind by Privacy Statement posted there.

Communication Preferences

You can stop the delivery of future promotional e-mail from Maximum Global Business sites and services by following the specific instructions in the e-mail you receive.

Security of Your Personal Information

Maximum Global Business is committed to protecting the security of your personal information. We use a variety of security technologies and procedures to help protect your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. For example, we store the personal information you provide on computer systems with limited access, which are located in controlled facilities. When we transmit highly confidential information (such as a credit card number or password) over the Internet, we protect it through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

If a password is used to help protect your accounts and personal information, it is your responsibility to keep your password confidential. Do not share this information with anyone. If you are sharing a computer with anyone you should always choose to log out before leaving a site or service to protect access to your information from subsequent users.

Use of Cookies

Maximum Global Business websites use "cookies" to enable you to sign in to our services and to help personalize your online experience. A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies contain information that can later be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer.

Maximum Global Business websites use cookies to store your preferences and other information on your computer in order to save you time by eliminating the need to repeatedly enter the same information and to display your personalized content and appropriate advertising on your later visits to these sites.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to sign in or use other interactive features of Maximum Global Business sites and services that depend on cookies.

Use of Web Beacons

Maximum Global Business Web pages may contain electronic images known as Web beacons - sometimes called single-pixel gifs - that may be used to assist in delivering cookies on our sites and allow us to count users who have visited those pages and to deliver co-branded services. We may include Web beacons in promotional e-mail messages or our newsletters in order to determine whether messages have been opened and acted upon.

Maximum Global Business may also employ Web beacons from third parties in order to help us compile aggregated statistics regarding the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns or other operations of our sites. We prohibit Web beacons on our sites from being used by third parties to collect or access your personal information.

Finally, we may work with other companies that advertise on Maximum Global Business sites to place Web beacons on their sites in order to allow us to develop statistics on how often clicking on an advertisement on a Maximum Global Business site results in a purchase or other action on the advertiser's site.

Advertisements Displayed by Third Parties

The majority of the online advertisements you see on Maximum Global Business Web pages are displayed by Google AdSense. However, we allow third-party ad serving companies, including ad networks, to display advertisements on Maximum Global Business Web pages.

Ad serving companies often place a persistent cookie on your computer in order to recognize your computer each time they display an online advertisement to you. Because these companies may serve advertisements on many different websites, they may be able to compile information over time about where you, or others who are using your computer, saw and/or clicked on the advertisements they display. These companies may use this information to make predictions about your characteristics or preferences and to display targeted advertisements that they believe may be of interest to you. They may also associate this information with your subsequent visit, purchase or other activity on participating advertisers' websites in order to determine the effectiveness of the advertisements.

These companies may offer you a way to opt out of ad targeting based on their cookies. Some of these companies are members of the [Network Advertising Initiative](#), which offers a single location to opt out of ad targeting from member companies.

Controlling "Spam" or Unsolicited E-mail

Maximum Global Business is concerned about controlling unsolicited commercial e-mail, or "spam." Maximum Global Business has a strict anti-spam policy prohibiting the use of your email account to send spam. Maximum Global Business will not sell, lease or rent its e-mail subscriber lists to third parties. While Maximum Global Business continues to actively review and implement new technology, such as expanded filtering features, there is no currently available technology that will totally prevent the sending and receiving of unsolicited e-mail. Using junk e-mail tools and being cautious about the sharing of your e-mail address while online will help reduce the amount of unsolicited e-mail you receive.
